CSL Limited – Request for Trading Halt

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, CSL Limited (ABN 99 051 588 348) (ASX code: CSL) (CSL) requests the implementation of a trading halt in its ordinary shares to apply from the commencement of trading today, 14 December 2021.

CSL provides the following information for the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.1:
